## **Assembly Instructions**




Fig 2 –Socket




Fig 3 – Assembled Pin & Socket

**Note:** Snap Lock Hunting Blinds uses a pin (see fig 1) and socket (see fig 2) system to adjoin the panels. To assemble correctly, the pin is inserted into the *non-recessed* side of the socket (see fig 3). When assembled, **the logo on each panel will face to the outside of the blind.** 




Fig 1 – Pin





Fig 4 – 6 ft. panel assembly

**Step 1.** If assembling 4x6 model, join top section of long side wall to bottom section keeping pins (see fig 1) on each section to the same end (see fig 4). Push down on upper panel until it locks into lower panel. Repeat for second long, side wall.





Fig 5- Align & Snap together panels

**Step 2.** Join the first two wall panels by aligning the five pins of one panel to the five sockets of another and press to snap panels together (see fig 5). Repeat to adjoin all four wall panels of Blind (see fig 6).




Fig7 - Install Roof Panel

**Step 3.** Place roof panel on assembled wall panels (see fig 7) and secure the roof panel to wall panels in all four corners using provided cable ties (see fig 8).

#### ROOF PANEL MUST BE INSTALLED OR SERIOUS INJURY MAY OCCUR.





Fig 9 – Side Cable Tie

**Step 4.** Insert additional cables ties through holes in corners of adjoined wall panels (2 per corner, one near bottom & one near middle) (see fig 9).

Check cable ties a minimum of 6 times per year. Replace worn or brittle ties as needed. **Failure** to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!




Fig 10 – Install Platform Attachment Straps

**Step 5.** Use the platform straps to attach blind to platform or tower (see fig 10 & 11). Use bolts, Washers and locknuts or deck screws with finishing washer to prevent fasteners from pulling through strap. Platform straps may be rotated to fasten blind to floor or to side of platform. For best door operation, insert door latch locking pin to keep door square in frame while attaching assembled blind to platform.

Fig 11 — Fasten Blind to Platform using bolts washer and locknuts or deck screws with washers.




If you are elevating your platform please use only architectural approved designs. Never lean or push on walls. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!



### **Window Kit Assembly Instructions**

- **Step 1.** Attach the knob on the inside face of the panel (the side with no logo), through the predrilled hole located just below and to the center of the window opening with the pan head screw. (see fig 1).




Fig 2 –Insert Window

- **Step 2.** Facing the outside of the panel (the side with the logo), hold the window with the tabs at the top, the long cord facing up and the short loop at bottom facing down. Gently bend the window enough to insert the tabs on the window into the two holes located on each side of the window opening (see fig 2).
- **Step 3.** With the window inserted, insert the long cord through the predrilled hole located over and center of the window (see fig 2). From the inside of the panel, attach the ball stop to the end of the cord. Adjusting the ball stop along the cord will allow you to adjust the extent of the opened window. The lower inside loop and knob allow you to secure the window in the closed position.
